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When to Water, How much to water, and How to Keep the Water!

In this video, I talked about the three things about watering your Bucket Garden, When, How much, and How to Keep the Water in your Bucket.

Tools:

Watering can or hose.

Moisture meter / Moisture, light, and PH meter

Material:

Water

Directions:

How to Water:

If you can, use a watering can so the chlorine in the water can evaporate; usually, it'll take overnight.

First, you wanna measure how much moisture is in your soil bucket garden. You're going to take 3 depths of measurement; the first measurement is 1 inch below the soil, the second measurement would be halfway down in the depth of your Bucket, and the last measurement would is one inch from the bottom of your Bucket.

How much to Water:

Do a thorough watering if the moisture is light at all three levels.

If the top of your soil is dryish, then do a lighter watering.

Retest the moisture after an hour to allow the water to flow down through the soil.

How to keep the Water:

The easiest way to retain the water in your soil is to mulch. Use grass clippings and leaves. There is a video on 'Where to find Organic Materials in the City' if you need some.
