Getting Your Worms

Once your order your Worms from Jim's Worm Farm, prep a bucket to receive them. If they come in before your bucket is ready, Jim has a plan to help you; there are instructions in the box that your worms come in.

Tools:

The only tool is a box cutter.

Material:

Worms from Jim's Worm Farm https://unclejimswormfarm.com/?affiliates=755

Directions:

- 1. Remove the worms from the shipping box as soon as possible. The bag that the worms come in is an 'airbag"; it allows air to flow into it, thus allowing your worms to breathe.
- 2. Take a quick smell check to make sure that they didn't die.
- 3. Add some Corn Meal to your bucket.
- 4. Add water to wet the Corn Meal.
- 5. Pour in your worms and spread them around.
- 6. Check on your worms in a few days to ensure most are alive.
